

A School for All

Pupils at our school are educated according to the educational programme for children with mental illnesses and multiple disabilities – “A School for All”.

Lessons are carried out in four classes from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. The attendance of each individual may vary depending on their health condition.

We also offer after school care from 7 a.m. in the mornings and from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. in the afternoons.

There is a maximum of six pupils in each class. Pupils are allocated to individual classes based on their specific needs. Each class has its own class teacher, qualified in special-needs education, and an assistant.

The school offers special-needs education at nursery school, pre-school, and elementary school level, and courses teaching the basics of education.

Our school provides all-day food with a possibility of having a special diet. Parents can also use the assistance services of our partner, the Stodůlky Centre, which is located in the same building.

Who we are

Since our establishment in 1995 we have focused on the education and upbringing of children with severe multiple disabilities. Pupils with medium, heavy and severe mental illness combined with physical disabilities, autism and other forms of disability fulfil their compulsory ten-year school attendance at our school, with the possibility of completing it until they are 26 years old.



What we provide

In addition to special-needs education services we also offer a number of other services, such as physiotherapy, hippotherapy, massages, bubbling baths, relaxation in the snoezelen room and an annual rehabilitation stay in the countryside, etc.

Physiotherapy

Our physiotherapists work with pupils on an individual basis. They choose methods and techniques according to the pupil's specific needs. They have at their disposal a water-bed, rehabilitation room with an adjustable table, a gym with special balls, barrels, a pool with balls, etc.



Massages

Massages are regularly performed for our pupils. Students of the 2nd and 3rd year of the four-year "Health and Sport Massage Therapy" course, which ends with a school-leaving exam of the Aloyse Klara Secondary School, come to our school as part of their professional practice.



Therapy dog

A female Golden Retriever visits our school once a week. Our pupils can lie with Kessinka, caress her, touch her, and feel her breath and warmth, which helps them warm up and gradually relax their muscles.



Hippotherapy

Every Monday some pupils travel to Hucul Club in Zmrzlik for horse riding. It is sometimes quite cold there, but the atmosphere is pleasant and horse riding always warms us up.
